WORKSHOP

Categories

1. Ethnic music workshop (night time)
2. Drawing and props making workshop (night time)
3. Poi and fire dancing workshop (night time)
4. Photography class (night time) and working tour (day time)
5. Sailboat riding (day time)

Description

Ethnic music workshop:

The participants will be introduced to the ethnic musical instruments from different parts of our country, teach them about the significance and how to use them properly then let them explore the instruments. Introduce them the difference of sounds and music, the facilitator will guide them to compose their own musical piece by groups. We will try to mount an ethnic musical presentation at the end of the session. Sessions start on **April 29 up to 30, 2010** (3 hours per night session). You have to check in earlier to participate in the workshop.

Drawing and props making workshop:

The participants will be guided to explore their environment and observe the lines, patterns and shades. Introduce the importance of elements in drawing. The facilitator will teach them to create their own composition base on the subject they choose from the environment, teach them to use recycle materials as their medium on creating their artwork. All finished or unfinished artwork will be exhibit on the workshop area and will become back draft of our stage for the presentation. Sessions start on **April 29 up to 30, 2010** (3 hours per night session). You have to check in earlier to participate in the workshop.

Poi and Fire dancing workshop:

The participants will be introduced to the poi's, and let them explore the moves and some routines to create movement techniques. Teach them the dos and don'ts on playing the poi's. They will be taught some choreography on poi dancing and later introduce using the poi with the fire. Participants will have a chance to create their own group of poi dancers or fire dancers and the facilitator will guide them to create their routines and choreography to mount the show. Sessions start on **April 29 up to 30, 2010** (3 hours per night session). You have to check in earlier to participate in the workshop.

All of the above workshops will have a chance to show what they learned and accomplished through a production number at the end of second day session.
