

Minimum Requirements of an OPHTHALMOLOGY CLINIC

An ophthalmology clinic is a room purposely designed for ophthalmic consultation and examination, whether it be a stand-alone unit, or a part of another health facility, such as a multispecialty clinic, an ambulatory center, or a hospital. As such it must have the following:

1. Manpower

- 1.1. An affiliated ophthalmologist





2. Equipment:

- 2.1. Penlight
- 2.2. Slit Lamp
- 2.3. Visual Acuity Charts for distance and near
- 2.4. Direct Ophthalmoscope
- 2.5. Retinoscope or autorefractor
- 2.6. Trial Lens or phoropter
- 2.7. Tonometer, preferably Goldman type of applanation tonometer
- 2.8. Gonioscope
- 2.9. Indirect Ophthalmoscope or Fundus Lens

3. Medical Records System

4. Supplies

- 4.1. Diagnostic drops
- 4.2. Occluders
- 4.3. Pinhole
